Show Information & Rules

THE Casino Classic HORSE SHOW is open to all breeds of horses. It is approved by the Appaloosa Horse Club. Horses will show together in the same class, but results for ApHC registered horses will be produced separately.

SHOW LOCATION

The show will be held at **Horseman's Park**, 5800 E. Flamingo Road, Las Vegas, Nevada 89122. Visit *equineevently.com* for a link to a map and directions. The facility is east of the 15 and 515 freeways, with major cross streets of S. Nellis Blvd. and S. Boulder Highway.

ENTRIES

Pre-entries are encouraged and close **March 10, 2024**. Entries submitted after this date will incur a \$25 late fee. Our **Show Secretary** is **Sheila Shiffert**; telephone her at **909-938-5098** or email her at **sheila.shiffert@gmail.com**. You may submit entries two ways:

Verification of Records—Show Management must inspect all ApHC certificates of registration on horses being shown in approved classes for which points are being tabulated. Entries are to be made in the name of the current recorded owner or owners as indicated by records on the certificates of registration presented. Verbal statements of transfer or photocopies of transfers will not be accepted. 2024 ApHC membership cards, photocopies of cards or proof of payment must be presented for each owner and exhibitor. 2024 membership fees must be paid prior to showing. If proof of membership is not available, membership fees may be paid at the show. Membership forms are available in show office.

Membership—All exhibitors and owners competing in this ApHC approved event who want to accumulate points must be current 2024 members of ApHC. See *Verification of Records* (above).

Youth & Non-Pro/Amateurs—All Youth and Non-Pros/Amateurs competing in Youth or Non Pro/Amateur Classes who want to receive ApHC points must be aware of and abide by ApHC horse ownership rules.

Youth and Non-Pro/Amateur Walk/Trot Classes—Youth and Non-Pro/Amateur exhibitors cannot cross-enter in the Walk/Trot and three-gaited classes at this show. These classes are limited to Youth and Non-Pros/Amateurs who do not participate in any other approved classes at this show except Showmanship, Halter, Hunter in Hand, Heritage, In-Hand Trail and Walk/Trot.

APPALOOSA BREED INFORMATION

Appaloosa Breed Points—Appaloosas and other breeds will show together in the same classes, but separate results will be submitted to ApHC. Not all classes are ApHC approved.

Performance Halter—Horses may not enter both their age classes and Performance Halter. Horses that place 1st or 2nd in Performance Halter are eligible to compete for Grand and Reserve in their respective divisions.

GAMES CLASSES

All youth 18 & under *must* wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets with safety harness attached and fastened in all Games classes. While helmets and safety harnesses are optional for adults, it is strongly recommended that all exhibitors use such equipment in all Games classes.

All exhibitors in all games classes at ApHC approved shows and the parents or guardians of all exhibitors who are minor children are required to sign a *Games Release Form* before participating. This form is available in the Show Office.

HUNTER HACK CLASSES

It is mandatory for all riders in Hunter Hack classes and when jumping anywhere on the show grounds to wear properly-fitting protective headgear that meets ASTM/SEI equestrian standards. The helmet must be worn properly fitted with the harness secured.

DOGS

Dogs must be on leashes at all times. Dogs in the stall areas must either be on leashes or secured (crated, in a pen or tied). No pets are allowed in the Show Office.

STABLING INFORMATION

Stall Rate—\$85 per stall or tack room. Bedding is not included. Stalls are available at 12 noon, Thursday, March 14. Stalls must be vacated on Sunday, March 17.

Early arrival or after-show layover—If you need to arrive earlier than Thursday, March 14, please call Danie Bogner at 760-981-9484 to arrange early arrival at a rate of \$20 per night. The fee is also \$20 if you layover and leave after 9 a.m. on Monday, March 18.

Shavings—Please call Danie Bogner at 760-981-9484 to purchase shavings at an estimated \$10 per bag (price may vary depending on market price at the time of purchase). You will pay for your shavings through the show office as part of your show bill. Exhibitors are welcome to bring their own shavings, but we have a show requirement that each stall must have at least one bag of shavings.

Haul-in Fee—One-day fee: \$15 per horse. Two or more days of the show: \$20 per horse.

RV SPACE RENTAL

Please call Danie Bogner at 760-981-9484 to make an RV reservation. 30 RV spaces available at \$25 per night, which includes full water and electricity hook-ups.

First-place winners in each class will receive an award for each judge. Grand and Reserve Halter Champion Stallion, Mare and Gelding will receive specially selected awards. Separate awards will be given for All Breed and Appaloosas. All 1st & 2nd place halter horses in respective age classes or performance halter, regardless of breed, are eligible to participate in All Breed Grand & Reserve Halter.

All-Around Awards —One horse/one rider. You must show in one open halter class appropriate to your horse, one Western class and one English class to qualify for all-around awards. Please refer to the qualifying class list.

All-Around Open —Classes 4, 8, 12, 22, 27, 29, 53, 65, 74, 79, 101, 107, 109, 111, 114, 117, 119, 137, 141, 147, 151, 155, 158, 161, 168, 174, 180, 186. You must show in one open halter class appropriate to your horse.

Open Games Horse—Classes 168, 174, 180, 186. You must show in one open or color halter class and two games classes to qualify.

Open Ranch Horse—Classes 147, 151, 155, 158, 161. You must show in Ranch Conformation All Ages and two ranch classes to qualify.

Open Cattle Horse—Classes 30, 33, 36, 38, 44. You must show in two cattle classes to qualify.

Division High Point Awards—All Division High Point Awards will be calculated on a one horse/one rider combination. You must show in a division- appropriate halter class (Youth must show in a Youth halter class, Non-Pros/Amateurs must show in a Non-Pro/Amateur halter class, etc.) and a minimum of two performance classes in that division to qualify for an award. Please refer to qualifying class list.

Note: All Games classes are *Time Only*, not horse against horse. Appaloosa horses seeking Appaloosa Breed Points must run in accordance with ApHC Rules for *time only* (i.e., to the right barrel first). All Breed horses may start to the left or right barrel as preferred.



Trail Maturity Rules

- 1. Owner and Exhibitor do not need to be members of any association.
- **2.** No requirement that horse be entered in any other class at Casino Classic. Applicable fees apply in addition to entry fee.
- **3.** Trail Maturities do not count toward High Points and are not ApHC approved.
- **4.** Horse may enter BOTH Trail Maturities; however, the same horse/rider combination cannot enter both Trail Maturities.
- **5.** The aggregate score from three judges will determine final placings.
- **6.** 100% of \$25 Entry Fee payback: 1st Place–60%, 2nd Place–30%, 3rd Place–10%.
